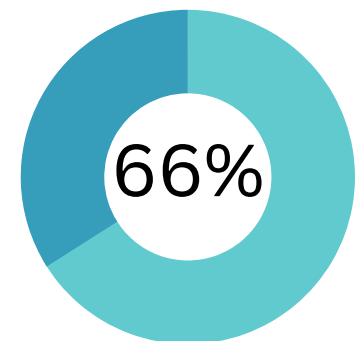
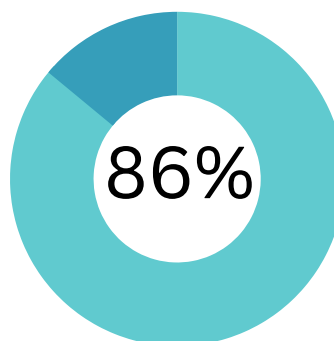

She never showed for that next appointment and we were fearful that she aborted. We prayed that she would answer when we called, but her phone was no longer in service.

One week later she called, apologizing for not coming to her appointment. Her phone had been turned off and now she had it back and wanted to reschedule. She came for her ultrasound and has decided to have her baby!
